#### Report 03-18 to the Assembly under Standing Order 22.9

The **Remuneration Board** considered the Standards of Conduct Committee **report under Standing Order 22.9** at its meeting on 17 January 2019.

The Board has commenced its review of the Determination for the Sixth Assembly, and is currently considering the issues contained within Part One of the review, which includes the provisions surrounding the Office Costs Allowance.

#### Response to the 03-18 report under Standing Order 22.9

The Commission has been asked to consider recommendations made by the Standards of Conduct Committee and the Commissioner for Standards in their 03-18 report under Standing Order 22.9.

I am aware that the Remuneration Board has also been asked to consider the recommendations and will write to you separately. However the purpose of this letter is to provide the Commission's response to these recommendations.

The Determination outlines the requirements regarding accessing the Office Cost Allowance. Members Business Support (MBS) offers advice and guidance to Members to enable them to make best use of the financial support available. MBS has developed a booklet on *how to acquire a constituency or regional office*.

The guidance contains matters Members should take into consideration when finding an office and negotiating a lease. We therefore accept your recommendation that the Assembly Commission produces a checklist for Members which suggests areas to consider and steps to take when finding an constituency office. MBS will extend this guidance to include a checklist.
