As you know, we have been informally tasked by the authorities in our respective Houses to develop an agreed position on the establishment of the Parliamentary Partnership Assembly (PPA). Discussions on the PPA between the two Houses and with the European Parliament are ongoing and we will keep you informed as the situation continues to develop.

All of us understand the importance of the UK's evolving relationship with the EU, including its impact on areas of devolved competence.
