I would like to take the opportunity to introduce myself as Chair of the Sixth Senedd's Legislation, Justice and Constitution Committee.

As a Committee, we are mindful of the recommendation of <u>The Commission on Justice in Wales</u> that the Senedd should take a more proactive role in the scrutiny of the operation of the justice system in Wales.
