In Plenary on 19 January 2016, I promised to provide you with further information on the Emergency Medical Retrieval and Transfer Service (EMRTS) Cymru.

The following table provides a breakdown of activity in each local health board area for the period between 27 April 2015 and 31 October 2015 (the latest reported information available).

There were also 6 neo-natal and maternity transfers during this period although a breakdown between the local health board areas is not available.

In addition, 19 patients were taken to hospitals in England.
