Standing Order 30A - Consent in Relation to Statutory Instruments made by UK Ministers

Thank you for your letter of 24 February drawing our attention to Government responses to two of your recent reports on Statutory Instrument Consent Memoranda.

Business Committee considered the letter on 28 February and noted that Senedd officials are already in discussion with Welsh Government counterparts about ways in which Standings Orders 29 and 30 might be updated. We agreed that options for reviewing Standing Order 30A (alongside related Standing Orders) will be brought to the Business Committee in due course as part of its broader programme of procedural reviews.

In the meantime, I have indicated that I intend to write to the First Minister to clarify my expectations on the matter of Senedd consent in relation to statutory instruments made by UK Ministers. I will provide you with a copy of this letter once it has been sent.
