
### Senedd Cymru (Members and Elections) Bill: Response to recommendations made by the Reform Bill Committee

# Response to the Reform Bill Committee's recommendations

## **Recommendations 4, 5, 17, and 25** relating to the Business Committee's proposed procedural review

**Business Committee response:** Accept recommendations 4, 5, 17, and 25

1. The Business Committee will consider these recommendations when it comes to establishing terms of reference for its Senedd Reform-related procedural review.
2. The Business Committee intends to consider draft terms of reference in the latter part of the Summer Term 2024, once there is certainty around the legislative changes that are to take place.
3. Subject to the Bill receiving Royal Assent, the procedural review is anticipated to begin during the Autumn Term 2024.

## **Recommendation 42** which calls on the Business Committee to consider proposing the establishment of a new committee in the Sixth Senedd to explore issues relating to job-sharing, or asking an existing Senedd committee with a relevant remit to undertake such work
