**Abolition of the Right to Buy and Associated Rights (Wales) Bill passed by the National Assembly for Wales on 5 December 2017**

Thank you for your letter of 6 December 2017 reminding me of my power under section 112 of the Government of Wales Act 2006 to refer the question of whether an Assembly Bill, or any provision of a Bill, would be within the Assembly's legislative competence to the Supreme Court for decision.

I am of the view that none of the provisions in the Abolition of the Right to Buy and Associated Rights (Wales) Bill is outside the legislative competence of the National Assembly for Wales and, therefore, I do not intend to make a reference.
