- 3. Presentation from Greg Lloyd and Susan Tuckett on WAST approach to sepsis.
 - -ST gave an overview of how telephone calls are received, triaged and prioritised via the Medical Priority Despatch System (MPDS) in order to determine where best to despatch their ambulances.
 - GL gave an overview of how WAST staff treat and prioritise patients using a variety of means and how they communicate with secondary and tertiary centres via the 'common currency' of NEWS.
 - -GL gave an overview of WAST improvement programmes.
 - -GL/ST talked through the East of England Ambulance Service/MPDS trial which looks at identifying calls for clinical support desk to review when patient reported as scoring positively on any of the below:
 - · Having recent infection diagnosed by HCP

- Cold clammy pale or mottled skin
- Breathing faster than would normally at rest
- Unable to pass urine in last 18 hours
- Recent cancer/chemotherapy treatment or surgery
