I am disappointed that the Committee has not yet received a response to our report 'Review of The Water Resources (Control of Agricultural Pollution) (Wales) Regulations 2021'. The report was published on 8 June 2022 and the deadline for a response was 14 September.

Plenary unanimously tasked the Committee with urgently reviewing these Regulations last year. The urgency of the motion, and the fact it was passed unanimously underlines the importance of these Regulations.

Whilst I understand the period of mourning may have caused some delay with the release of the response, the Government has had the whole of the summer recess to prepare. I would have expected the response to arrive no later than 20 September.

I would appreciate the Government issuing its response forthwith and an explanation of the reason for the delay.
